All completed applications must be received by 4:30 pm on Friday, May 1, 2020.

- A) Eligible applicants must be a member in continuous good standing and have paid dues without an Honorary Withdrawal. A member meeting the above requirements may sponsor an immediate family member.
- B) All applicants must be attending, or accepted to an accredited college, university or vocational trade school.
- C) All application packages must include:
  - 1. □ Completed application form.

    A complete detailed personal resume outlining education, work history, military service, plus involvement in the Union, local, civic community, and religious organizations.
  - 3. □ One letter of recommendation.
